Scholarship Award

Description: Established in 2011, the TAA provides two college scholarship awards annually, one to a female student and one to a male student who meets all eligibility criteria and best reflects TAA's mission by exemplifying the characteristics of sportsmanship, dedication, honesty, loyalty and commitment to community.

Criteria: To be eligible for the TAA College Scholarship Award applicants must have:

- Participated in the TAA programs (any level or amount of participation is acceptable);
- Eligible for and planning on attending some form of post-secondary education (2 or 4 year college, trade school, etc.)
- Completed the application below with the inclusion of the required information;
- Met the application deadline;
- The winners must produce proof of registration from the post-secondary education institution. This letter is not required at the time of application or award announcement. However, the scholarship will not be awarded to the winner without a letter of registration.

Amount: A range of \$750.00 – \$1,250.00 per award

Deadline: Applications will be accepted from February 15th to April 30th. If mailed, applications must be received or include a postmark of no later than April 30th.

Selection: The selection committee will represent officials from the Tabernacle Athletic Association. The winner will be notified by TAA by phone, email, or mail. The intention is to select the winner no later than May 15th.
